<p>Dates when concerns were received 16/09/2024 and 15/01/2025:</p> <p>16/09/2024:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> It has been reported that on the 13/01/2024 the mother went to the paternal grandparent's house with a friend, there was no one at the house. One relative was living there, she said they took Harseerat to India. A week later father sent divorce papers that was on 24/01. Mother had no contact with daughter since then.

- Concerns of Sexual Harassment: This is based on both eyes were sore, red mark on the neck - observed on 08/09/2024. Paternal grandfather records all the calls. Notifier believes he physically abuses Harseerat after the call. the video always used to get paused during the call.
- Father also uses to threaten mother that he will kill her and would physically abuse her. When father got his 491 visas, he beat mother up again and kick her out of the house. Mother did not report to police as it would become police matter and create issues with the visa. Mother is trying to put recovery order for Harseerat, but since paternal grandparents have taken her to India it is becoming very difficult. Harseerat was just in Australia for 72 hours and then they took her back.

15/01/2025

- Notifier reported that the child is believed to have been in DPO Batindia, India, with her paternal grandfather and grandmother, it is believed child still is in India.
- Notifier reported that in 2019 QPS and CS where involved.
- Notifier reported that around 4-5 days ago last week left Australia to go to India to keep the child and possibly move to Canada.
- Notifier is aware that the MO saw the child over facetime in September and December 2024.
- It is reported that the MO is concerned FA will get a "dodgy passport" and sign for MO and take her to other country.
- Notifier is aware that the MO is talking to international Social services Australia/ ISS
- Notifier is aware that there are ongoing court matters:
- Family law court was held on 9 December 2024
- FA asked to dismiss the case as India is not part of the high convention country.
- Next mention 17 December 2024
- FA did not show up, magistrate advised FA to attend, Feb 4 2025.

Summary of the Child Protection History:

There is CP history since 2019:
 - 6 x intakes
 - 1 x unsubstantiated
 - 1 x substantiated

Themes of neglect, physical and emotional harm

26/09/2019 Child Protection Notification 5 days (Neglect, Physical and Emotional harm): It has been identified that due to the baby being a girl, Harjinder is less likely to show an attachment to the baby. Domestic violence is reported within the relationship which may also result in Harjinder becoming jealous of how much time Anmolpreet is spending with the baby, as a result the baby may not have their needs met. It has been reported that Anmolpreet is showing symptoms of mental health concerns following giving birth to the baby girl on 25/09/2019. Anmolpreet has also been reported to not show any attachment to the baby whilst in the hospital. This has been identified as a risk to the baby and may

result in the baby having no parent willing and able to provide care to them. Due to the baby's age, they are solely reliant upon the parents providing care to them and meeting their needs.

There is a risk of physical harm to the baby following reports of domestic violence within the relationship. It has been reported that Harjinder has strangled Anmolpreet on a number of occasions, and reports of Anmolpreet being burnt by a candle on her lower abdomen when pregnant. It has been identified that the domestic violence increased at the time that Anmolpreet and Harjinder found out that the baby was a girl. As a result, there is an identified risk of the baby experiencing physical harm.
