Hospital Course

Baby born at outside hospital on 18.10.2024 at 8.06 AM with birth weight of 1.820 Kg. Baby referred to Clio Hospital in view of recurrent feed regurgitations. On examination, low anorectal anomaly was found for which child was operated & anoplasty was done by Dr. R.J Singh under general anesthesia. Post op child was managed with IV fluids, IV antibiotics, IV fluids, analgesics and other supportive care and was kept NPO x 48 hours. Baby passed stool on 2nd post op day. Gradually, OG feeds were started on 3rd post op day followed by spoon feeds. IV antibiotics were stopped after 5 days. Currently, baby is accepting & retaining feeds well, passing urine & stool adequately, so, being discharged in a stable condition.
