Subject: Urgent Complaint Regarding Mental and Physical Harassment - Request for Immediate Action

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Niharika Sri, resident of Patna, Bihar, aged 17 years, am writing to file an urgent complaint regarding the mental and physical harassment I suffered from my maternal aunt (Mosi) Kanchan Devi and her husband (Mosa) Ranjit Mehta during a wedding event held at my maternal grandparents' house between 2nd March and 9th March 2025.

During this period, both the above-named individuals repeatedly insulted me, verbally abused me using degrading language, accused my family with false and humiliating remarks, and even physically pushed me. This constant harassment severely impacted my mental health and disturbed my focus, especially since my 12th Board Exams were scheduled from 11th March to 1st April 2025.

I have two family members as direct witnesses who were present during these incidents and can verify my statements. I was mentally disturbed, and my health deteriorated due to the stress. I could not report this earlier due to lack of support from my parents.

Complaint Regarding Mental and Physical Harassment

I am unable to leave home without permission, so I am reaching out via this written complaint. I request you to please take necessary action and register my complaint.
