Subject: Complaint Regarding Dummy School Practices and Violation of CBSE Attendance Norms in Odisha, Berhmapur region

Respected Sir,

I am writing this letter to draw your attention to a serious malpractice being carried out under the guise of education in Berhampur, Odisha. The Aakash Institute, Berhampur branch, is allegedly associated with two schools — Sankalp Senior Secondary School, ralaba and Gurukul International School, Berhampur — which are operating as dummy schools in clear violation of CBSE norms.

Students enrolled in these schools are not attending regular classes as required under CBSE's 75% attendance rule. Instead, they spend the entire academic year studying at Aakash Institute for JEE/NEET preparation. These schools neither conduct proper classroom teaching nor hold regular practical sessions or co-curricular activities. Students visit the schools only during examinations or for formal documentation purposes. This system has created tremendous mental pressure on students. While trying to manage the stress of both JEE preparation and board requirements, we are unable to properly complete or revise the CBSE syllabus. The pressure often leads to frustration, many parents scold or blame their children for poor academic performance, even though the real issue lies in the lack of proper school support. In the previous academic year, in this dummy schooling system, students from these schools failed in all subjects or at one subject because of in aware of board pattern and absence from

regular school activities. Such practices clearly violate CBSE's norms.

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28/11/2025	<p>At Sankalp Senior Secondary School, there are two legitimate sections - Section A and Section B designated for regular students who attend regular school classes. However, the school has also created two additional sections, Section C and Section D (there also exists a whatsapp group named), meant solely for students admitted under dummy admissions. Shockingly, no such classrooms actually exist within the school premises, when we go to school (twice a week), we are made to sit in the seminar hall (Room No-201) only for documentation purposes, such as signing attendance registers and submitting record notes. No actual teaching or academic activity takes place during this time. School conducts schedule for Monday and Wednesday till our 75% attendance criteria is not followed as CBSE regulations and by-law's.</p> <p>Therefore I request you to have a strict action and disciplines against it by CBSE norms and rules and laws for this crucial condition.</p> <p>At Sankalp Senior Secondary School, dummy admission students attend school only twice a week — on Mondays and Wednesdays (sometimes it also not followed)</p>
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— merely to maintain attendance formality, without any real academic engagement. Only a few students, who perform exceptionally well due to Aakash coaching, are being highlighted to maintain the school's reputation, while the majority of students struggle silently under pressure. Such practices not only violate CBSE's regulations but also harm the integrity of the education system and the FUTURE OF STUDENTS.

I sincerely request that my identity be kept confidential, as I wish to remain anonymous for safety reasons.

I therefore request your good office to kindly investigate this matter and have a surprise inspection (exclude Monday and Wednesday) take strict disciplinary action against the institutions involved so that genuine education, attendance, and student welfare are maintained as per CBSE norms.

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Aakash Berhmapur is dealing dummy admissions with Sankalp Senior Secondary School, Raiba and Gurukul International School. Students come to institute in 2 batches (morning and evening) for JEE/NEET coaching and often in Monday and Wednesday twice a week go to school for formalities with not much more attention by school administration. These schools neither conduct proper classroom teaching nor hold regular practical sessions or co-curricular activities. Students visit the schools only during examinations or for formal documentation purposes. This system has created tremendous mental pressure on students. While trying to manage the stress of both JEE preparation and board requirements, we are unable to properly complete JEE/NEET and the CBSE syllabus. This not only violates integrity of education but also harms the mental health of students because of lack of regular schooling, regular lab works and co-curricular activities, instead of this school gave the record notes of previous year students to write and complete our records and have to submit, and also school administration says they will manage our practical and viva. So please take the necessary further action that school will not sign LOC of CBSE without 75 percent attendance and will maintain genuine education.

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After a raise of complaint arose school arranged regular classes for dummy students, regular school timing is 8am to 2pm but our school timing is 8am to 11am but for regular students revision test is now going on so our class is suspended now, we are compromised by school in every field. Without 75 percent attendance our LOC is signed, yet our English is not complete but school planned preboards for us from 29th NOV 2025. So Honourable Sir /Madam have a strict disciplinary action according to CBSE norms and bye-laws to save the future of us and to maintain genuine education. If we want to stay in school upto 1:40 pm regular school timing, we have to write application that we have to stay in school and clear our doubts. So I humbly supplicates that Honourable Sir/Ma'am please have

**a strict disciplinary action according to CBSE rules and regulation as soon as possible for save our future and genuine education. Before it our previous principal sir questioned school director and chairman sir for planning our regular classes at the starting of class 12,so school administration removed him from school and also removed several teachers from school because dummy students failed in their subject in board exams,Now only and only school administrative(not any teacher) is responsible for our such crucial condition.
